SBIRT: Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment

The Alcohol Screening (SBIRT) is **MANDATORY** by the State and American College Surgeon for Trauma. (American College of Surgeons |2022 Standards | Resources for Optimal Care of the Injured Patient 5.30-5.31)

The CAGE screening is a **requirement on all injured patients admitted** to Medicine or Trauma Services. A minimum compliance required is 80% for each CAGE screening and SBI consult/intervention.

The National Trauma Data Standards (NTDS) states, traumatic injuries sustained greater than 14 days must be excluded. In other words, any traumatic injuries sustained 14 days or less must have an alcohol screening.

HCA Bayonet Point uses the CAGE screening tool which stands for **C**ut, **A**nnoyed, **G**uilty, and **E**YE.


The CAGE Assessment is a set of questions that are used to show a possible substance abuse dependency (ages >12 & older).

It is a patient-driven questionnaire→only the patient may answer.

The qualifier is **NOT** alcohol for CAGE screening. The qualifier is **ADMISSION WITH AN INJURY**.

The intervention is to assist our patients and have compliance by interdisciplinary team members.

To complete the CAGE screening, go to Process interventions and complete the Admission Health History or Risk/Safety/Regulatory intervention.

Language cannot be used as a reason because the hospital has a language line and encouraged to be used.

Once patient is alert & oriented (GCS 15) the CAGE screening needs to be completed prior discharge or transfer.

Answering Yes to the query: Admission due to Injury will bring user to complete CAGE screening.

Injured from a Fall, MVC, MCC, Assault, self-inflicted, GSW, Stabbing, etc. It resulted in any type of injuries: head bleeds, TBI, concussion, any fractures, and etc. This box would be marked **YES**.

CAGE score:
Item responses on the CAGE questions are scored 0 for 'No' and 1 for 'Yes' answers.
A total score of two or greater is a positive test.
Need to reduce alcohol consumption:>Yes*

Felt guilty about your drinking:>Yes*
Need a morning eye opener to steady nerves or get rid of a hangover:>No*
CAGE score:>3 Positive

File the intervention. If the CAGE screening is greater than or equal to 2, an **order for SBI consult** to notify Case Management is required. **Fill in the ordering physician's name** (usually "Assign to Physician" on admissions' orders), **and order source (Z)** for Dept Process/Procedure.

Click Submit. The consult will notify Case Management to complete the SBI Consult.
