Teach/Educate: Anticoagulation Teaching



Current documentation for anticoagulation teaching involves specific references to warfarin. Newer anticoagulants are being prescribed that have a different mechanism of action than warfarin. BH Module

Behavioral Health Outpatient Initial Nurse Assessment: Nutrition Assessment



The **BH Outpatient Initial Nursing Assessment (INA)** includes nutrition assessment fields but is not a complete nutrition assessment per TJC guidelines. The complete nutrition assessment has the potential of being left undocumented if it is not completed within the BH Outpatient Nutrition Assessment. Nutrition Assessment questions have been removed from the BH Outpatient Initial Nursing Assessment, and should be documented in the **BH Outpatient Nutrition Assessment**.
