- No problems while sleeping

Yellow Zone: Watch Out

Early Signs of Asthma


- Cold symptoms
- Coughing day or night
- Wheezing day or night
- Funny feeling in chest

Red Zone: Emergency!


Late Signs of Asthma

- Tight chest
- Breathing hard or fast
- Using neck or stomach muscles to breathe
- Constant coughing
- Trouble talking or walking
- Vomiting
- Lips or nails blue


Descriptions for Green level – Child is well, Yellow level – Child is NOT well, and red Level – child feels awful have been updated to better describe what the child would look like/feel like in those zones.



Free text medication options were created for each level



The dose and route/frequency were separated due to character limitations. The responses can now fully display to the patient on the printout.



Additional group responses added for "Strength" queries:

- 1.25 mg
- 2.5 mg
- 90 mcg/puff

Modifications made to group responses on Dose, Route and Frequency queries. Removed all group responses that include "inhalation", now says "puffs".
