Revive is a user friendly, intuitive, hand-held solution for nurses [documenters] to electronically record a code blue event in real-time. Users should open the Revive App from the iPad placed on their crash cart to get started.

Code Blue Team arrives with crash cart



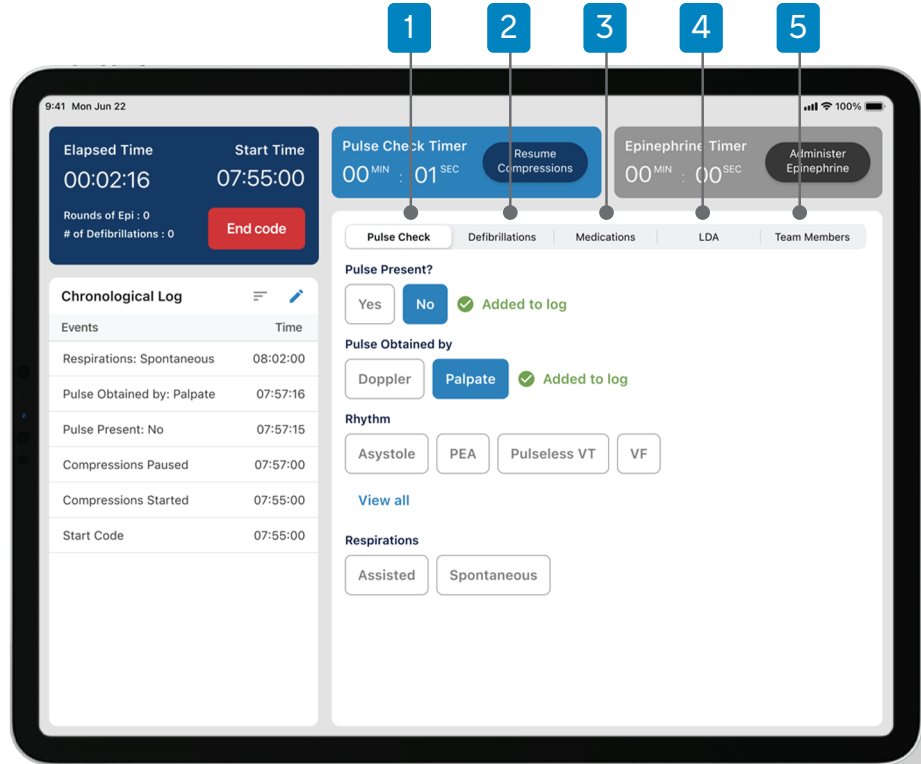
Documenter grabs iPad from crash cart

After code blue ends, documenter selects End code button on iPad.



Documenter logs into Revive app with username/password



Documenter collects patient demographics



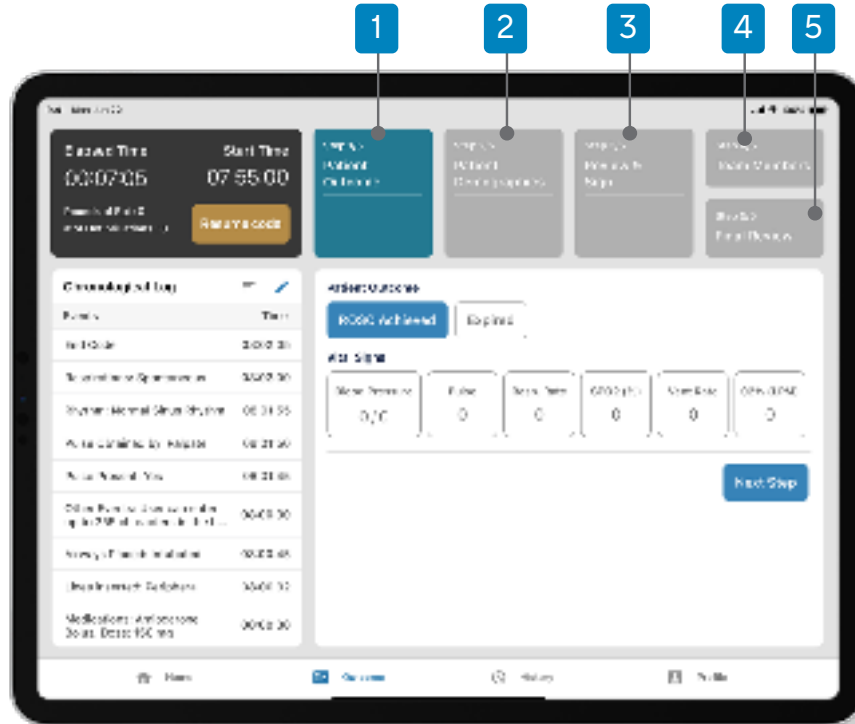
Review and add team member names and credentials



Documenter and provider authenticate and electronically sign

Post Code Blue Documentation

Once Code Blue has ended, the documenter selects the End Code button. This will stop all elapsed times being captured and begin the patient outcome area. Look at the chronological log and update information as needed. Users will be required to login to authenticate their information. Once logged in, you will be able to enter patient demographics, finalize team members involved in the code blue and then review and sign.
