

Non-Verifiable Employment Gap Form

The Non-verifiable Gap Employment Form is used to satisfy the Joint Commission requirements for evaluation that professionals have the experience required by the job responsibilities performed. This form is intended to supplement information obtained through the background check verification for gaps in employment exceeding 90 days and is not intended to take the place of the employment history verification.

Gaps in employment may happen for a variety of reasons, some examples of applicable situations are:

- Destruction of records due to natural disasters
- Countries where employment is not verifiable
- Company closure or job seeking
- Family leave or sabbatical (please do not provide health or protected information)

This form will be used to seek an exception in the evaluation of required experience. There is no guarantee by completing this form that an approved exception will take place.
